A warm and kind invitation to attend the ISLANDS 2026 congress in Berlin in May 2026!

We are proud to host the 2026 ISLANDS meeting in Berlin, Friday 8 May (pre-congress course) and Saturday 9 May (scientific congress).

We will provide an exciting program in the vibrant city of Berlin, Germany.

On **Friday**, there will be a guided tour in the Department of Obstetrics, Campus Charité Virchow, between 14.00 and 15.00 o'clock. Then we will relocate to Charité Campus Mitte (pictured below) for the practical pre-congress course on intrapartum ultrasound. This course begins at 16.00 o'clock and will contain a series of short mini-lectures by ISLANDS faculty, followed by practical lectures with live-demos by the Charité staff. More educational material (overview and how-to lectures) will be provided online, too.

On **Saturday**, the congress will contain a packed scientific program.

Submissions: Only unpublished data or recently published studies (publications during the 24 months preceding the congress) or study proposals will be considered for live presentation. Proposals must be submitted online via the congress website ISLANDS2026.com (see QR code) . Each participant may present only one lecture live. Submission of further lectures is possible, but such lectures must be submitted as video recordings (max. 10 minutes each) and, if accepted, will be available to registered participants for eight weeks after the event. The deadline for all submissions is 14 February 2026.



ISLANDS 2026 will end **Saturday** evening with a congress **dinner** at a special location.

Congress and course content will be in-person events, not online. Some content will be available online after the congress for viewing by registered participants only.
